Discover Scuba – Try Dive

So do you know if you like diving or not? The Discover Scuba Programme from PADI is a chance for you to find out. The course gives you the opportunity to find out what its like to breath under water with scuba gear. This session is carried out in a swimming pool under the full and direct supervision of a qualified PADI instructor. First, your instructor will show you the scuba equipment and explain its operation. When you're happy with this you'll be given a hand to put on the equipment and take that first breath underwater beginning what could be one of the biggest experiences of your life. Cost £20.00

Open Water Course

This has to be the most popular dive course in the world leading to a fully recognised certification, allowing diving to a maximum depth of 18 metres adults and 12 metres for junior open water. The course consists of a period of self-study undertaken in your own time. The course also consists of classroom sessions, five confined water dives and four in open water. Training schedules can be as flexible as you require with all modules being broken down and delivered suiting your individual needs.

Advanced Open Water Course

So you've completed an Open Water Diver course, got a few dives under your belt. Maybe you want to improve your skills? This package is made up of five open water dives. Two of these are core dives, which have to be completed. They are the deep dive and underwater navigation. The remaining three can be chosen from a list of speciality courses. Cost £275.00

Emergency First Response

The PADI Emergency First Response and First Aid course is designed to give you the skills and understanding required in the event that you were called upon to help another in difficulty, whether it be at work, diving, or at home, you will be able to deal with the situation confidently. The first part of the course is Primary Care in which you'll practice and learn CPR. The next session is First Aid where you'll learn to recognise other symptoms enabling you to make quick decisions, apply bandages etc and maintain a circle of care until the professionals arrive. This course is delivered at your pace using video and workbook training. The sessions are practice based giving you plenty of opportunity to practice your skills. Cost £75.00

Rescue Diver

Up to this stage your training has been based on the buddy system. What if your buddy got into trouble? Or maybe you found another diver in difficulty. What would you do? The PADI Rescue Diver course is designed to give you the skills required to deal with accident prevention and management. To gain entry onto this course you must be an Advanced Open Water diver or Advanced + (or equivalent). You must also have a PADI Emergency First Response and First Aid Certificate (or equivalent) and have logged at least 20 dives. During the PADI Rescue Diver course you'll learn how to foresee, prevent and manage potential diving accidents. Handling possible emergency situations are accomplished using scenarios that build up the knowledge and skills required to overcome most problems in the unlikely event they arise in or out of the water.
